Our primary goal is that every single person who calls Declaration home would actively engage and participate.

We want to seek Him and His Kingdom first and we desire radical devotion to Christ and His Kingdom for every follower of Jesus. Seeking Him first includes every area of our lives: lifestyle, influence, legacy, and generosity.

Giving is an important component of our worship of God and reflects the truest nature of our hearts. Jesus had a lot to say about money. In fact, He linked these things together when He said, "Wherever your treasure is, there the desires of your heart will also be" (Matthew 6:21).

Through our secondary goal of multiplication, we are advancing the pace of an indelible footprint in our community. This anchor, this home, will act as a root, giving stability as we grow wide and expand our reach and impact of the Gospel.

Setting the Table for Multiplication will also sow into Declaration's heart a vision for church planting in areas outside of Spring, like Tomball and beyond. Equipping is essential for church planting and multiplication and so we look forward to development of leadership pipelines and a strategic partnership with a Bible seminary. Theology and leadership classes will be held on our own campus.

Our secondary goal in multiplication is to continue construction on our permanent footprint in this community and expand our influence through leadership and planting.

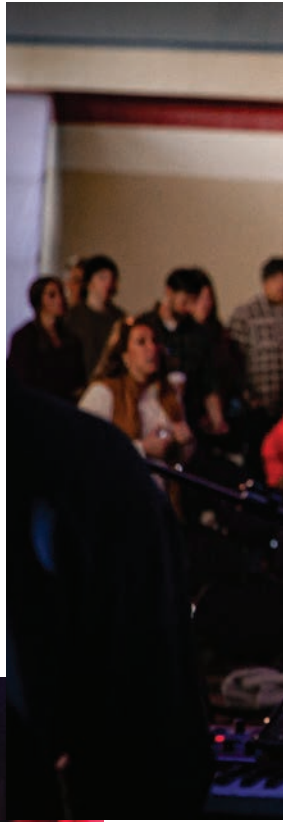

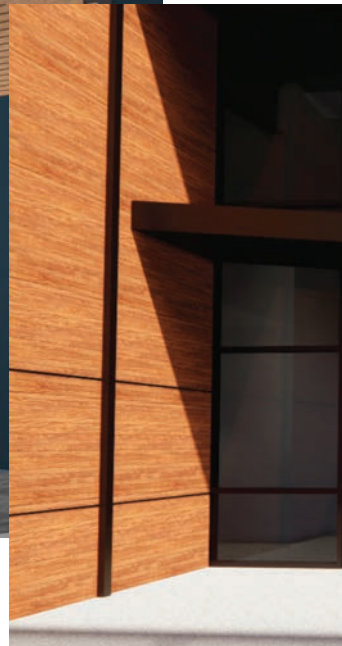

- Declaration will further develop leadership pipeline strategies within Generations, Worship, and campus church planting.
- We will work towards the opening of a Mothers Day Out in order to serve families and share the Gospel with those in our community.
- We will solidify a strategic partnership with Bible seminaries. These programs at Declaration's first campus will be designed to develop Biblical literacy and discipleship by comprehension through both non-degree and accredited programs.

What Is Your Role?

New Commitment

You recently joined our church family and are wondering, “What is the Setting the Table Initiative and how do I become a part of it?”

Setting the Table is for anyone who would call Declaration their church home and we welcome you to the family! We hope you will join us on this journey to SET THE TABLE in every area of your life and consider making a 12-month generosity commitment to Setting the Table.

Finish Strong

Others committed one year ago and perhaps, for some of you, this journey has been difficult—or possibly more difficult—than you envisioned. Maybe you went to an entirely new level in your generosity and are still adjusting your life to it. Perhaps you have experienced job loss, job change, or unexpected financial expenses. Persevere to finish strong in this journey you began. We all stand together, encouraging one another. We know the Lord is faithful. He will provide, and we want to finish strong in our commitment to the Setting the Table Initiative.

Increase

Some of you made your Setting the Table commitment one year ago and it is possible you had an increase in faith or finances. Keeping your commitment may not have been easy and it has likely required many sacrifices, but, even now, you may be sensing the Lord stretching you to take an additional step of faith in your generosity. We challenge those of you to respond to His generosity by increasing your commitment.

Generosity is not a one-time event; it is a journey. Consider asking yourself this question: *Am I still giving in a way that challenges me?*

Pray and ask yourself if He is inviting you into another step of faith with an increased commitment.

The Journey of a Giver

The Journey of a Giver is a tool designed to move us from money being our “god” to money being a tool for God’s Kingdom. Each step represents growth in a lifestyle of generosity and sacrifice, all in a heart desire to be transformed into the likeness of Christ. These are not steps we ascend to God with, but simply a way to do what scripture encourages us to do—to grow in every area of our walk with Christ, including the grace of giving (2 Cor 8:7).

PRIORITY GIVER



A Priority Giver is someone who understands the pre-eminence of Christ and that He is before all things – that all things were created by Him, for Him, through Him, and to Him. This giver places such a significant priority on their giving that it drives their spending and their saving, as opposed to their spending and saving driving their giving. Priority Givers experience the freedom of serving “one master” and declaring Jesus is first (Matthew 6:19-24 and Colossians 1:15-20).



CONSISTENT GIVER

A Consistent Giver is someone who decides to give something and to give it on a consistent basis to exercise the discipline of giving as a disciple of Jesus. Often, someone who decides to make their gift an online recurring gift will be someone who is learning the joy of consistency. Non-online givers can be consistent givers as well, of course; it just requires more discipline. Consistent Givers experience the joy of excelling in this grace of giving (2 Corinthians 8:7).



INITIAL GIVER

An Initial Giver is someone who decides to give for the first time, out of a response to God’s Word about giving. This is someone who decides to give something and trust God and the leaders of the Church with this gift. Initial Givers experience the initial joy of putting Jesus’ words into action (Matthew 7:24).

SURRENDERED GIVER



A Surrendered Giver is someone who recognizes that Christ surrendered His whole self for us, and therefore desires to surrender their whole selves to Him, in love (Ephesians 5:1-2). This giver would say, "My giving is not just changing my spending and saving. It's also changing me!" Surrendered Givers also look at what they're not giving away and ask, "Is it surrendered too?" They use everything they've been blessed and entrusted with, whether that be through direct monetary giving or through a God-honoring use of an existing resource (i.e. honoring God with the use of your home, etc.)

ETERNAL GIVER



An Eternal Giver is someone who sees the eternal impact of their giving—on them and on others—not just the immediate programs and ministries it helps accomplish. This giver has been captivated by the knowledge that the more they are led to "do good, to be generous and ready to share," the more they "take hold of that which is truly life" (1 Timothy 6:19). This encourages the Eternal Giver to keep growing! This giver makes all decisions (big purchases, savings, giving, relationships, areas of service) in light of how it will affect eternal impact.

Q U E S T I O N S F O R R E F L E C T I O N :

1. God called Abraham (Abram at the time) to follow Him into a land that He would show him, a land that was unknown to Abram. He asked him to leave everything he knew. The only known thing he had with him was his wife and God. Has God ever called you to do something that felt like the unknown? How did you respond?

2. God gave David the very important task of gathering the resources so that Solomon could build the Temple of the Lord. Following God in this task was not easy and it required David to gather together leaders that would follow him and give specifically and sacrificially. In what areas of your life is God asking you to follow Him in right now in your life?

3. Completely following God isn't often easy. It requires us to lay down our own desires and preferences so that we can follow Him, even when we don't understand the full path or the full plan. What is something God is asking you to lay down or sacrifice so that you can better follow Him?

P R A Y :

Jesus, let nothing stand in the way of me giving my whole heart, mind, and life to You. When You call, when You speak, when You lead, Jesus, I want to follow with my whole heart. Give me clean hands and a pure heart before You. May my motives be pure. Jesus, help me to follow You, even when it requires sacrifice. Help me follow You, even when the path feels unknown. Give me a passion for serving You with my whole heart. As my hands are on this plow, Jesus, give me the faith to not turn back. When You say go, Lord help me say, "Here am I!"

GENESIS 22:1-19

Q U E S T I O N S F O R R E F L E C T I O N :

1. God asked Abraham to surrender the one thing that he had waited for his entire life, his son (99 years to be exact). It seemed unbelievable, but yet God had a plan. Have you ever had an “Isaac”? Have you ever had something that God was asking you to give up that seemed so impossible to do? What is your “Isaac”?

2. Notice in v. 5 the faith that Abraham had that God would provide a way somehow for Isaac to get to come back with him. Do you believe that God will provide for the “Isaac” He is asking you to surrender?

3. Often times the things God is asking us to surrender are so that He can do a work IN us. It’s not even really about the thing we are surrendering; rather, it’s about our act of surrender. Have you found this to be true in your own life? How so?

P R A Y :

Jesus, help me trust You and obey You in every way. May my heart be so in tune with Your heart, that I can't help but to be obedient to Your call and commands. Hide Your Word in my heart that I may not sin against You and increase my faith that I may rise and walk in passion for Your name. Out of love and gratitude, Father, I pray for a desire to die to self, so to live fully alive, following You in total obedience. I pray this for myself, my family, my church, and my community.

MATTHEW 21:1-11

Q U E S T I O N S F O R R E F L E C T I O N :

1. "The Lord needs them." Have you ever heard this phrase spoken or prompted to you from God as it relates to any of the resources in your possession? How did you react?

2. Open-handedness to the resources God has given us isn't easy; however, it is so rewarding to see God using the resources we give Him in amazing ways. How have you seen God use a resource you offered up to Him?

3. Giving comes in many forms. Sometimes we give direct financial gifts to move God's Kingdom forward; other times we offer up pieces of our life, our home, our possessions to God's people to show His love to them. Regardless of the specifics, our open-handed posture should reflect that our resources actually don't belong to us. Our resources belong to God. Do you embrace this truth fully? How might God be challenging you to grow more in this during this present season?

P R A Y :

Father, everything I am and everything I have is by You, through You, and most important FOR You. Nothing I have is off limits to You, and nothing You have given me is more important than You. Take my life, and everything about it, and use it for Your glory and to build Your Kingdom. Give me passion for Your great Name and for Your glory. May my desires reflect Your desires and my heart reflect Your heart. Give me joy to be a living sacrifice unto You.
